About 5.5% of our population have hepatitis B & <1% hepatitis C. Nine out of ten don't know about the existence of both the viruses in their body. They suffer and silently transmit the viruses to other members of the family. Treatment of viral hepatitis is costly and needed for long time. Most of them are unable to bear the treatment. The situation is more complex when several members of the same family are affected.

The foundation started Zakat Fund in the 2014 for support the treatment of underprivileged young hepatitis B & C affected persons. They are either student(s) or active member(s) of the family. You will be happy to know that **221** (**Two hundred twenty one**) hepatitis B & C affected young patients from different parts of the country received free treatment in this program. Every beneficiary (patients) express their whole hearted gratefulness to Allah (SWT) and the donors. They believe that this kind of life saving support is a miracle and a blessing for him/her and their family. This initiative was highly appreciated nationally and internationally, specially by World Hepatitis Alliance (WHA), Geneva.

The Foundation likes to continue the service in much broader form in coming days, so that much more needy patients will get the benefit and will have ray of hope for survival. About 3.5% pregnant woman has hepatitis B in Bangladesh. This is the most common cause of transmission of hepatitis B.
